

## WEST VIRGINIA

Voters in the Mountain State will elect a new governor, attorney general, and treasurer in 2024. All 100 seats in the state house as well as 17 of 34 state senate seats will also be on the ballot in November. Republicans are expected to maintain control of all executive offices and the legislature.

### Larry Pack

Larry Pack is currently the Acting Secretary of Revenue after being appointed to the role in December 2023. He served in the West Virginia House of Delegates from 2020-2022 before resigning his seat to join Governor Jim Justice's (R) administration as a senior advisor. Pack also serves as the Chairman of the West Virginia Economic Development Authority. Before his career in public service, Pack operated elder care companies and nursing homes as well as founded an accounting firm.

Pack is campaigning on **opposition to ESG** (Environmental, Social, and Governance) investments; improvements to financial literacy and education within the state; and stronger financial outcomes for families.

To address **financial literacy**, Pack plans to institute education for middle and high school students on finances, household budgets, retirement, and other basic financial tools.

Protection of **public pensions** and **retirement** accounts is the tenet of Pack's plan to improve financial outcomes. Pack believes this begins with proper financial management of taxpayer funds by the state and limited government spending.

As the only candidate running for the office, Pack has a clear path to becoming West Virginia's next state treasurer.
