Voters in Missouri will elect a governor, attorney general, and state treasurer this year. All 163 seats in the House of Representatives, and 17 of 34 seats in the Senate, are also up for reelection. Larry Sabato's Crystal Ball rates the gubernatorial race as Safe Republican, and the Cook Political report rates it as Solid Republican.

State Representative Crystal Quade

State Representative Crystal Quade (D) assumed her current office in 2017 and began serving as Minority Leader in 2019. Quade has served on the House Budget Committee, the House Government Efficiency Committee, and the Joint Committee on Child Abuse and Neglect. She was also elected vice chairperson of the minority caucus by her Democratic colleagues.

Quade has been <u>highlighting</u> **healthcare** issues throughout the campaign, including the closure of rural hospitals in the state and the state's maternal mortality rates. She pledges to "take on" insurance and drug companies for high prices. And, to protect abortion and IVF access in the state.

Quade has been <u>endorsed</u> by former Governor Bob Holden (D), the Sierra Club Missouri Chapter, and others.
