Voters in Utah this year will elect a governor, Lt. governor, attorney general, and treasurer. All 75 Utah House of Representatives seats are up for reelection as well, along with 14 out of 29 senate seats. Republicans are expected to maintain control of the executive offices and retain their supermajorities in both chambers of the legislature. The state has been under Republican trifecta control for over 30 years.

Neil Hansen

Neil Hansen (D) advanced to the general election as the Democratic Party's only candidate for treasurer. Hansen was a member of the Utah House of Representatives from 1999-2011. He has served in various leadership positions with the Weber County Democratic Party. Hansen was also a delegate at the Democratic National Convention in 1992, 1996, and 2000. Hansen worked in construction prior to entering politics.

Trivia: Hansen has been a Heavy Equipment Operator for the Ogden City Water Department since 1981.
