

## **MISSOURI**

Voters in Missouri will elect a governor, attorney general, and state treasurer this year. All 163 seats in the House of Representatives, and 17 of 34 seats in the Senate, are also up for reelection. Republicans are expected to maintain control of the statewide offices and legislature.

## **Mark Osmack**

Mark Osmack was urged by the state Democratic Party chairman to run for office of treasurer. He is an Army veteran. Osmack previously ran unsuccessfully for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District of Missouri and for state senate.

Osmack <u>supports</u> creating a state program to fund early **childcare** similar to 529 accounts. He <u>pledges</u> to ensure unions will be considered for **state contracts**. Osmack hopes to increase resources for **first responders and teachers**.

His campaign <u>backs</u> providing school meals using Missouri agriculture products. Osmack additionally promises to protect **funding** for retirees and the state's farmers.
